| Main Table Negotiations Resume |

After a brief break, main table negotiations resumed last week with ASARCO management on August 5th.

At the bargaining table, we continued discussions about the drug and alcohol policy and attendance control. The Union made several proposals on Friday on those issues and day pay supervisors, leadpersons, and the grievance and arbitration procedure.

We expect a response when we meet with the Company on Wednesday, August 14th. This week's negotiations with ASARCO are scheduled from Wednesday through Friday.

Your continued support during this process is crucial to reaching our goal of a fair contract for all, so management must understand that we are united in our fight.

As always, we urge your continued solidarity in the days and weeks ahead. Be sure to check in regularly with your local union leaders and your CAT committee to stay apprised of upcoming actions.
