ASARCO SEEKS DRASTIC CUTS

Even though we were making progress at the bargaining table with non-economic issues, this week the Company gave us proposals on some economic issues.

ASARCO is proposing radical and far-reaching cuts to our contract, including freezing the pension plan, increasing the premiums, co-pays, and deductibles on medical benefits, and eliminating future retiree healthcare. ASARCO also wants to make drastic cuts to the copper price bonus by reducing the amount of the bonus and tying the bonus to attendance and production.

This proposal is **disrespectful** and a slap in our faces. We work hard for the Company every day—we are the reason why ASARCO is a profitable business.

The copper bonus is a way for us to share in the Company's success, but the **Company wants our shares to be smaller**. Our medical benefits are a way to care for our families in the present, but the Company wants us to shoulder **more of the burden** on that.

And, our pensions are a way to **secure our own futures** after a lifetime of hard work, but the Company wants **to take that away** from us too.

Bargaining has made it clear that we can't count on the Company to give us **anything**. We fought hard for this contract and we'll **fight hard to keep it**. Unity now is more important than ever. Mark your calendars now to **attend the next round of informational meetings**:
