### | PROGRESS IN NEGOTIATIONS |

Our negotiating committee met with Asarco/Grupo Mexico management on Wednesday, February 19th and Thursday, February 20th.

Our talks with the company yielded some progress, and we reached an agreement on a fair drug and alcohol policy that will help make our workplaces as safe as possible.

Importantly, we also traded proposals on successorship and neutrality. Successorship protects our union and our contract if all or part of a facility is sold, and neutrality strengthens our union by establishing a fair set of ground rules for organizing within the company.

Bargaining is scheduled to resume on March 10th, with additional meetings set for March 13th and 14th.
