ASARCO SETTLES NLRB CHARGE, FIRES RAY MINE HR MANAGER

Rather than face an official complaint before a National Labor Relations Board administrative law judge, Asarco/Grupo Mexico management has reached a settlement with the board over charges the USW filed in March 2014.

The settlement relates to a situation at Ray Mine, where an HR manager restricted union stewards' ability to attend meetings that could impact people's jobs and denied employees access to union representation, a violation of their Weingarten Rights – named for the U.S. Supreme Court case that upheld an NLRB decision that guaranteed workers the right to union representation at investigatory interviews.

The HR manager involved has been discharged by Asarco/Grupo Mexico, but not before a separate incident in which he grabbed and threw books at a member of USW Local 5252.
