<u>Don't Let HB 267 Become Law – Tell Governor Cox to Veto It Now!</u> (usw.to/58f)


After weeks of public opposition, HB 267, the latest attempt to ban public sector collective bargaining, has passed the Utah Senate and the Utah House of Representatives. Now, the bill is awaiting a signature from Governor Cox.

Collective bargaining is a fundamental right that allows workers to have a voice in their working conditions, ensuring they are treated fairly and with respect. It helps secure better wages, benefits, and workplace safety.

We need to act **NOW** to protect the rights of Utah's public sector workers and prevent this attack on workers' rights from succeeding.
