## **Utah Governor Signs Bill Banning Public Sector Unions**

Despite efforts by Steelworkers and our allies to prevent HB 267's passage, Utah Governor Spencer Cox signed it into law on February 14, 2025. As a refresher, HB 267 criminalizes collective bargaining for public sector workers, including teachers, firefighters, transit drivers, and other essential employees. It will take effect on July 1, 2025.
