This petition demands accountability and insists that Congress put working families first.

Our petition, Balancing the Scales for Workers, lays out six key demands that speak directly to the challenges we face:

- **Protecting workers' rights,**
- **Making health care and prescription drugs more affordable,**
- **Holding corporations accountable,**
- **Ensuring workplace safety,**
- **Defending retirement security, and**
- **Strengthening fair trade policies.**

It makes clear that working people are no longer willing to accept empty promises – we want real answers, real action, and leaders who fight for us, not just the wealthy and well-connected. This effort is about fairness, dignity, and the future of working families, and it signals that Steelworkers and their communities are organized, engaged, and paying close attention.

It's also about showing the strength of our union and the power of an organized, engaged membership. Use this packet to talk with members, collect signatures, and help us show our union's strength. Every name matters.
